INTRODUCTION

It is now 35 years since "Path of Hope in Ireland" was compiled, caste as bread upon the waters in 1983. It was not very long before what was shared in it was tested, tested by passing warnings from the spirit, tested by period of underemploymentopportunities to live as an "experimental Christian" words that have continued to ring in my mind since I read them on a tomb stone in the grounds of a church in Jedburgh in Southern Scotland in 1965. I guess that phrase sums up my life which has now reached three score years plus fifteen. Path of Hope was written at a time when we were planning to move to America to be nearer Marj's Parents, written to leave behind testimony of the goodness and faithfulness of God and the refreshed awareness of the call I heard over 50 years ago to follow Jesus and confess him as Lord. This book is an expansion and update of what was in Path of Hope including additional insights and experiences.

Introduction as included in Path of Hope 1983 follows.

Unity in Jesus is a possibility and the glory of God has been given so that we may be one in Him¹. I am writing because I have seen with my own eyes and experienced God's abundant life today. Many other wonderful things have happened during these past years, but this book is intentionally limited to what I personally know about. I wish to give God the credit and honour for all that has happened. I pray that more of the Lord's glory will be seen today and I ask that when the Lord speaks to you, you will listen and obey Him². Yes, obey Him just as Mary did when she was called upon to bear the Son of God. If you find what is written difficult to understand, please ponder it in your hearts³ and ask the Holy Spirit to teach you the meaning⁴ for the book is not just a story.

Basically I am an engineer. I am not a scientist, a theologian or church historian. An engineer is someone who uses formula that have been known to work rather than someone who is involved in **why** the formula work. What this book is supposed to be doing is sharing about formulae found in the Book of Books; the Bible; which I have believed; stepped out in faith on and found to work.

One of the truths the Lord has been talking to me about is that **one should not speak the truth**¹⁰ **to someone until one loves** them. Indeed, the person should **know** that one loves them. I pray that the parts of this book which are written with a view to helping
